## Minutes for Mitchell Campground Cemetery Business Meeting 2019

Billy pointed out there are three components of this story: Jesus, Zacchaeus and the tree. Some background information about the sycamore-fig tree is the tree can reach 60 feet tall, is thick with branches, the leaves can be up to 6 inches across and the tree is able to produce 6 crops per year due to their year round flowering fruit capability. Much like Zacchaeus, we need to focus on the Lord, not the crowd. But like the sycamore-fig tree, our trunks and branches need to be strong and we need to allow people to use us to see Jesus. Are we the people in the crowd holding Zacchaeus back or are we the sycamore-fig tree who has helped someone achieve a life changing encounter with Jesus?
